## 2 Research and Development


Develop equipment and "asobi" programs, research to create better parenting environments and collect resources.

Acces

By Train: Get on Linimo from Fujigaoka Station (subway Higashiyama Line) or Yakusa Station (Aichi Loop Line) and get off at Ai-Chikyuhaku Kinen Koen Station.

By Car: Get off at Nagakute Interchange on Nagoya-Seto Road (via Tomei Expressway Nisshin Junction).

Admission Hours: 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

Holidays: Closed on Tuesday (or the next day if Tuesday falls on a national holiday) and December 29th through January 1st.

Fee: Free for ages 15 and under, 300 ven each for others.


